YOUR SPORT CHAIRMAN SPEAKS:

On April 28^{th,} the first District 1 race was scheduled to happen at the Lambs site hosted by Still Crazy, but due to a terrible day of rain and wind along with other technical difficulties this race didn't happen.

Our attention shifts to the next race on the schedule, Nassau at Grant Park. A nice day with just the right amount of wind to make things interesting. A good turnout and just enough water in the lake to use the retrieve boat. The classes included Sport and Scale, G-1 Sport Hydro, Cracker Box, G-1 Mono and Open. Only one casualty this day, Ken Laux lost radio and hit the wall with his Unlimited. Duct tape wasn't going to fix this one. Sport 21 only had 4 entries. Ken laux out lasted the competition grabbing 1st followed by Gary Chandler, Chris Willet and Charlie Ott picking up the rear.

Sport 40 had 6 entries. Larry Zyp took first place having a perfect day followed by JJ Ditta, Jack Ditta Charlie Ott, Mike Noonan. Noonan came all the way down from Massachusetts to race.

Sport 90 had 7 entries. All but one boat ran on gas. Rich Berile continuing where he left off last year in this class having a perfect day with 1200 points followed by Lou Gerdik, Joe Venango, Roof Top Richie, Bill Ruffin, (a new comer to this class) Dave Willet and Charlie Ott. May 23 was the next stop on the schedule, LIMBA at North Pond. No water problems here, the lake was full. Cold morning to start, I thought we were in Bristol, PA in October. There was a bit more wind than at Grant Park which didn't effect any of the boats except the full body hydros. LIMBA ran Mono, Hydro, G1- Sport Hydro, G1-Mono, Sport and Scale. They put on a great race and had around 75 boats. This is the first time in a long while that we had 2 heats per round in Sport 21 and 40. Sport 21 includes 2 Kids that are improving every week in Chris Willet and Jake Sacken. Gary Chandler showing that last race wasn't a fluke took first place over a surprised Ken Laux. Charlie Ott was just having a bout of bad luck. Kenny took second followed by Jake Sacken, Jim Feretti, Charlie Ott, Tim Fischetto, Doug Reeve and Chris Willet.

Sport 40 had 8 entries with Bob Harless and Mark Ansanno as the new comers; next race Dave Neelman will make his debut. This looks to be a very competitive class in the months to come. Jack Ditta took 1st place followed by his son JJ, then Paul Vonsalzen, Mark Sacken, Charlie Ott, Bob Harless, Larry Zyp, and Mark Ansanno.

Sport 90 had 7 entries. Once again Rich Barile takes 1st place. Can anyone beat this guy? Once again Louie Gerdik takes 2nd followed by Dave Willet, Ed Provini, Joe Venango, Mark Sacken, and Roof Top Richie. Once again the fuel guys had a poor showing but I have a feeling that's about to change. Mark will be back. I will have my 90 ready by the next race and so will Charlie. We will be up for the challenge!

June 23rd LIMBA's second race of the season. Well... we were all waiting for the warm weather and we got it. Hot and humid and chasing needle settings all day. Almost 80 boats at this event. Charlie and the boys once again put on a nice race. I Hope we get some rain this year because the retrieve boat was hitting bottom a lot today. We'll start off with the Sport 21: Ken Laux is having his way with this class. He turned in a perfect day with 1200 points followed by Gary Chandler, who also is having a great year. Debris in the lake took me out 2 of 3 heats along with Jake Sacken and Charlie Ott each missing one heat.

Sport 40: Dave Neelman finally got his feet wet in this class and found it to be a little difficult. I'm sure by the end of the season he'll be a force to be reckoned with. Jack Ditta took first followed by Mark Sacken, Larry, Charlie, Dave, Bob and JJ.

Sport 90: 9 boats entered and I was the lucky boat not to score any points. Larry had his boat dialed in and had a perfect day with 1200 points followed by Rich with 1000 points, with Roof top Richie scoring his first wood of the season. Joe Venango consistently placing in the top 5 all year will be in the hunt at the end of the year. Dave Willet with Bill Ruffin also showed they have speed, just no luck. Mark and Louie round out the top eight, both with engine problems. Once again the Sport 90 class will be the class to watch. *PS:* The nitro guy's took this one making it 2 wins for gas and 1 for nitro.
